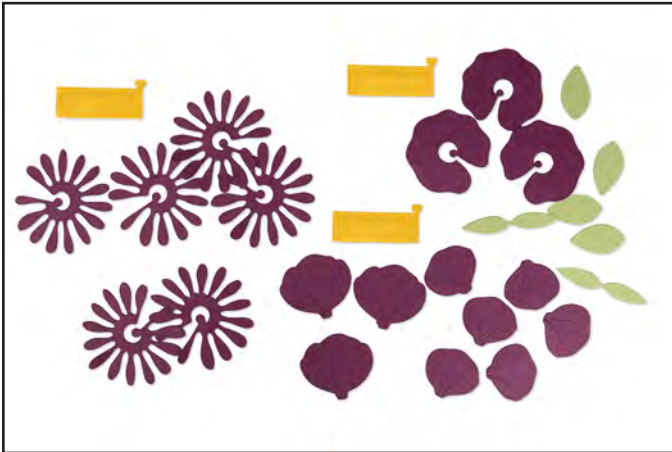




# 661988 Sizzix® Bigz™ L Die - Bundle of Flowers by Katelyn Lizardi



1. Die-cut out of desired material. Shown above are the parts necessary to create one of each type of flower.



2. Fold the stamen in half, and then tightly roll the stamen toward the end with the circle base. Adhere the base piece to the bottom of the roll. Spread and separate the stamen filaments.



3. Create the individual layers of the daisy as shown above. Base rings need little if any overlap. Middle and top layers need more overlap.



4. Adhere all of the layers together.



5. Use a pencil or dowel to add contour to the petals.



6. Adhere a stamen to the center of the flower.

7. Create the multiple-petal flower by first giving contour to each of the petals. Do this by drawing in the outer edges and gluing them to the center of the petal as shown.



8. Create the base by gluing the stem ends of the three large petals together. Adhere the medium and then the small petals to the base. Adhere the stamen to the center of the flower.



9. Create the single-petal flower by applying adhesive on the edge of the circular base piece, and glue to the corresponding edge. The base petal will have little overlap. The center will have about a 1/2" overlap, and the top petal will have about a 3/4" overlap.



10. The petals shown above are top, center and base.



11. Glue the petals together, and adhere the stamen to the center of the flower.



12. Attach leaves as desired.
